Yr Eisteddfod i gychwyn am **11.00 y.b.** (dan 5 i 11oed)

Eisteddfod to start at 11am (under 5 to 11yrs)

Fel y gwelwch uchod, mae'r Eisteddfod yn cychwyn am 11.00 y.b. Fel arfer, mae nhw'n dechrau gyda y plant dan 5 ac yna yn symud fyny'r oedrannau. Felly os ydy eich plentyn yn cystadlu o dan 5, a thros 5 ac o dan 7 (Meithrin hyd at FI 2) bydd angen i'ch plentyn fod yno erbyn 11. O ran y cystadlaethau hŷn (BI 3 i BI 6), dylech anelu i fod yno erbyn tua 11.30/hanner dydd achos anodd iawn rhagweld pa mor hir bydd pob cystadleuaeth yn cymeryd. Dyma rhai pethau pwysig isod.

- Partïon (llefaru a canu) i gwrdd a Mrs Corben a chyrraedd erbyn 2 o'r gloch os gwlewh yn dda.
- Disgwyliwn i bawb wisgo gwisg ysgol os gwlewh yn dda.
- Fe fydd tâl mynediad i'r Eisteddfod.
- Mae lluniaeth ysgafn fel arfer ar gael.

As you can see above, the Eisteddfod starts at 11.00 a.m. They usually start with the under 5s and then move up the ages. So if your child is competing under 5, and over 5 and under 7 (Nursery up to Year 2) your child will need to be there by 11. As for the older competitions (Yr 3 to Yr 6), you should aim to be there by about 11.30/noon because it is very difficult to predict how long each competition will take.

- *Parties (llefaru and singing) arrive by 2 o'clock please to meet Mrs Corben.*
- *Everyone is expected to wear school uniform.*
- *There will be an admission charge to the Eisteddfod.*
- *Light refreshments are usually available.*

We would like to emphasise that it is your responsibility to take your child to the Eisteddfod and also be responsible for them during the eisteddfod.
